Application Deadline: October 18, 2009 (postmark date)

Application Fee: \$5.00 nonrefundable per student performer. In an ensemble performance, each of the performers (except the student's teacher) should submit a fee. There is a 5-minute time limit per application; students may perform more than one piece as long as the time limit is not exceeded.

General Information: Students of all ages perform music outside the parameters of the normal standard repertoire. The intent is to showcase soloists and ensembles playing light music, such as show tunes, jazz, popular music and arrangements.

Both piano solo repertoire and ensemble music are welcome. Ensemble members may include the student's teacher, parent, sibling, another piano student or instrumentalist. All piano students must be currently studying with a member of the AAAPTG.

Because this recital will be held during the month of October, Halloween music is suggested (not required) and participants and audience members are invited to come in costume.

Music does not need to be memorized. Students do not need to announce their pieces because there will be a printed program.

Performers should arrive 15 minutes before the recital. Families need to allow plenty of time to park.

Performers will be determined on a first-come, first-served basis. The program will be approximately one hour in length. The Foundation Board reserves the right to review selections to be performed.

Teachers entering students will be asked to assist on the day of the recital.

"Ticket" Information: Because seating is limited, we suggest purchasing tickets in advance. The tickets are \$3.00 each and are a tax-deductible contribution to the AAAPTG Foundation. The ticket order form is included on the application. Those attending the recital will receive a receipt for tax purposes indicating the number of "tickets" purchased. No actual paper tickets will be issued. If seats are available, "tickets" will be sold at the door. Performers do not need to purchase tickets for themselves. Teachers entering students in the recital are not required to buy a ticket, however your purchase of a ticket is appreciated.
